

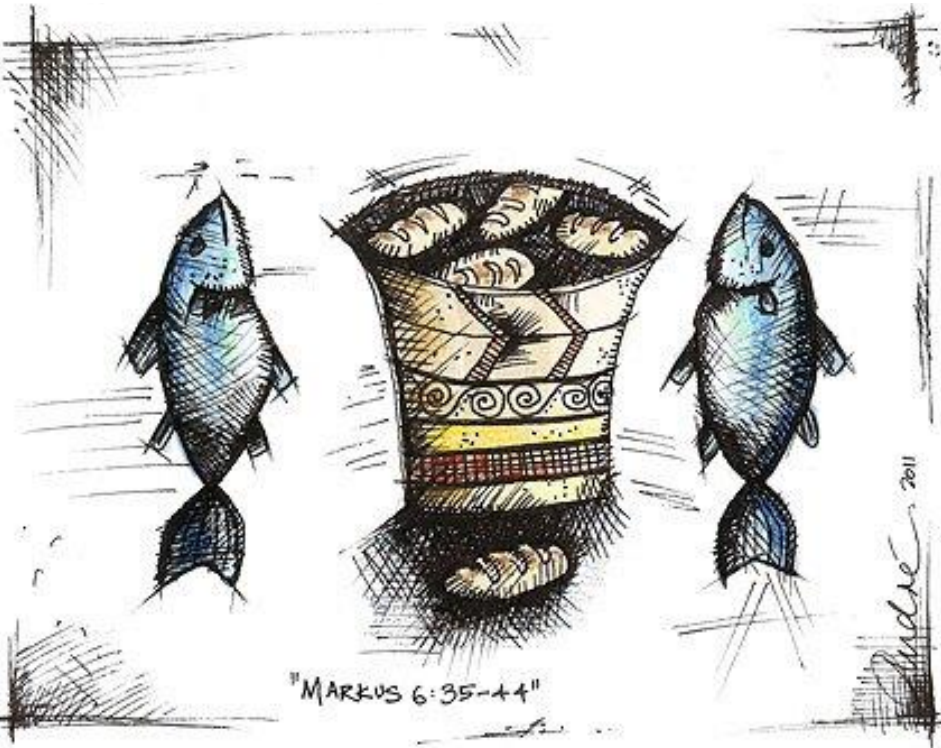

Summer Wednesdays in the Garden: Our normally scheduled Wednesday worship has moved outside for the summer months into the garden between the Church and Guild House.
