Organ Concerts at St. Peter's Church: For the first two Sundays in June, we will have two organ concerts at 3PM. The first concert is today, Sunday, June 2nd ~ Michael DiLeo will perform works by Bach, Buxtehude, Barber, and Widor. Michael is a recent graduate of Manhattanville University in Purchase, where he studied organ with Daniel Romero. He is also Director of Music at Grace Episcopal Church in White Plains. The second concert is next Sunday, June 9th ~ Dr. Adam Cobb will play a diverse program of music. Dr. Cobb is currently the Assistant University Organist at the University of the South, Sewanee, TN (one of the universities affiliated with the Episcopal Church,) and this summer he will begin as Assistant Organist and Choirmaster at Christ Church in Raleigh, NC.
